



## Consent Form

ThermaVein thermocoagulation is designed to eradicate red veins; thread veins; red spots; spider naevi and other facial blemishes. The principle is based on the action of a high frequency wave producing a thermal (heat) lesion with protection of the skin.

ThermaVein thermocoagulation is contra-indicated in patients who:

- Suffer from infectious skin conditions
- Are pregnant
- Are epileptic
- Have a pacemaker
- Take anti-coagulants
- Have fake tan product on the skin

Following treatment, the skin will be red and feel warm. In most cases redness will calm down within the day, depending on skin type. There may be slight redness in the skin surrounding the treated vein for a few days, but this can be longer. The skin may also be dry and have small crusts. The vessel will gradually fade and will be taken away by the body. Further treatments on the face can be carried out after 28 days.

ThermaVein thermocoagulation has a very good success rate and usually succeeds in its purpose. However, as with all cosmetic procedures it cannot be guaranteed and there is a possibility it may not work for you.
